As far as the nautilus is concerned, what I noticed is that if you take the inside spiral out of it and draw the outline of the nautilus and the spiral you get a semi-colon. That would fit in with the recurring theme (idee fixe?) of the "half" in this book. And what then???</p> <p>The magpie... yes, if you swing open the cottage window you see the magpie. Quite interesting. Try this: place transparent paper on the page with the cottage (61), ensuring that you align the paper with the page corner. Draw the part of the top-right window that is ajar (left side), remembering that Sufi can get in and out of the cottage through the kitchen window that is ajar. Now place the transparent paper on page 63 and align the corner. You will see that the window falls smack on the part of the sketch that has what seems to be partial letters. Actually, all partial letters fall within the window, i.e. if you were to cut out the window that is ajar (which I wouldn't do since it would destroy the book), what you would see in the opening is the partial letters. Now if you fold the transparent paper along the same folding line as the sketch, the bird shows up nicely in the window.
